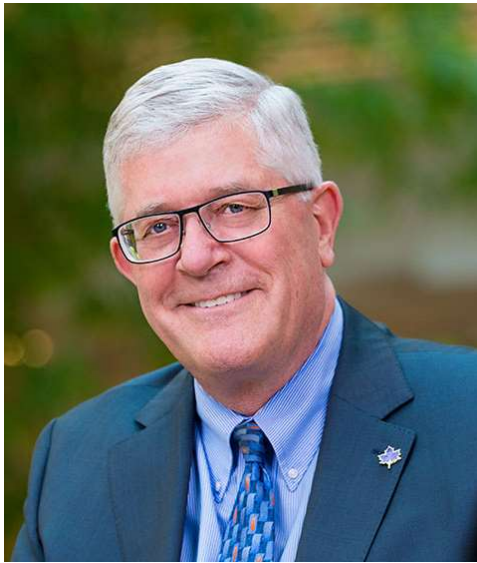

Dr. Max Blouw was appointed President of The Research Universities' Council of British Columbia effective October 1, 2019. He relocated to British Columbia from Ontario where, as President and Vice-Chancellor of Wilfrid Laurier University from 2007 to 2017, he championed evidence-based decision-making, research and graduate students. He also served as Chair of the Council of Ontario Universities and as a member of Universities Canada. Prior to that, from 1995 to 2007, he was professor of biology, and subsequently Vice-President Research, at the

University of Northern British Columbia. He has held lead roles in numerous organizations and has served on many boards, including three universities.

Dr. Blouw has BSc and MSc degrees from the University of Manitoba, and a PhD in biology from the University of New Brunswick. He is also an Institute of Corporate Directors Certified Director.
